



Other questions you may have...

Can I receive the subsidy if I purchase the insulation and install it myself?

No, to ensure optimal performance and safe installation, the use of an approved installer is mandatory under the ENERGYWISE™ programme.

Can I do just my underfloor insulation or just my ceiling?

Yes, if your existing ceiling or underfloor insulation meets the required standards, the grant can be used for the area that is not insulated. The ENERGYWISE™ programme requires both to be done.

What about wall insulation?

No, the programme does not currently allow for insulation in walls.

Can I pick the level of insulation I want?

Yes, to enjoy more warmth and comfort, it may be possible to choose insulation above the prescribed minimum levels and pay the difference. However you cannot receive the grant if you install below the minimum level set out in the criteria.

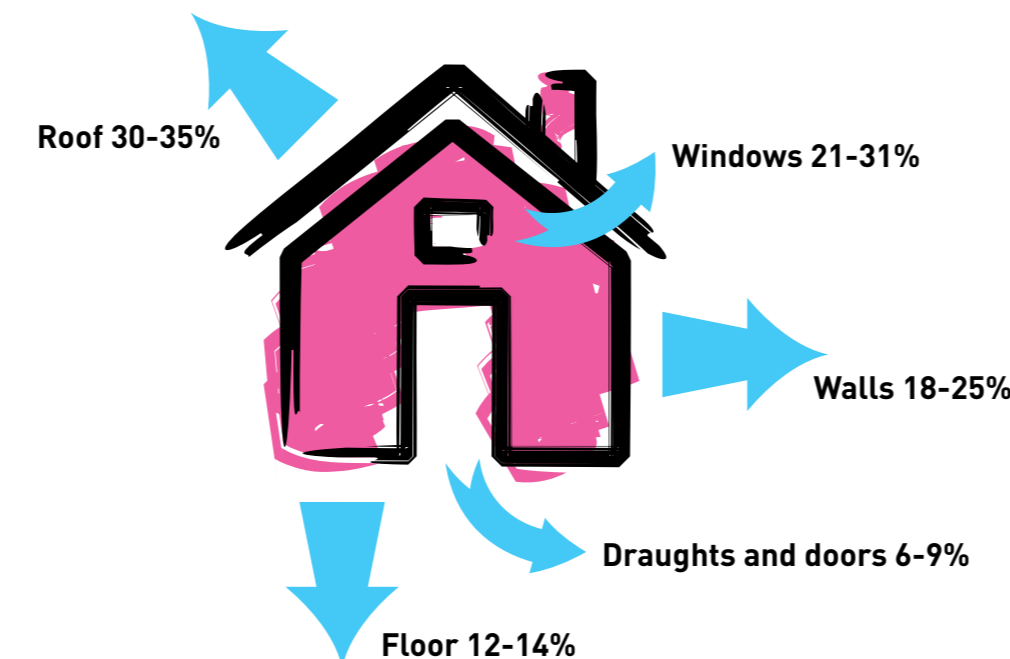
Why is it important to install Pink® Batts® insulation into existing homes?

Homes built before 2000 don’t have a very high level of insulation, and homes built before 1978 may not have any insulation at all. This means that New Zealand homes are often cold, damp, energy-inefficient and expensive to run. These cold, damp living conditions can trigger respiratory illnesses such as asthma.

Many homeowners attempt to fix these problems by putting in heat pumps, dehumidifiers and other devices instead of first addressing the fundamental problem – which is to stop the heat from escaping in the first place. What is it likely to cost?

- insulation for your pipes
- measures to stop draughts
- on ground underlay under the house to stop moisture rising through the floor
